

Agricultural Management, Economics and Sales Curriculum Frequently Asked Questions

What are the computer hardware requirements for accessing the curriculum?

We recommend the following:

- Computer: 1.3GHz processor or higher (32- or 64-bit)
- Memory: 256 MB minimum
- Display: 800 X 600 screen resolution (1,024 x 768 or higher recommended)

What Internet connection speed does the site require?

Internet access with minimum 256+ Kbps connection (higher connection speeds are recommended).
Downloading the zipped files for all units requires a good connection as it is a large file – 320MB.

Can I use any browser to run the site?

If you have a Windows-based PC, you can use any of the following browsers:

- Internet Explorer: IE8+ and works in all later versions of IE.
- Firefox: 10.0+ and works in all later versions of FF.
- Chrome: Works in all versions of Chrome
- Safari: Works in 5+ version of PC safari

If you have a Mac, you can use Safari 5 and later, Firefox, or Google Chrome. We recommend using the latest available versions.

Are there any required browser settings?

Please make sure your browser has JavaScript and Cookies enabled.

Do I need any plugins or other software?

Many of the documents on the site are in PDF format, so please make sure you have the PDF Reader installed on your computer. If you need the PDF Reader, you can download it from <http://get.adobe.com/reader/>.

You will also need to have access to Microsoft Office to open any Word, Excel, or PowerPoint documents you download.

1. Locate the link for zipped folder(s) you wish to download.

Mac

1. Locate the link for zipped folder(s) you wish to download.
2. Right click, choose to 'Save As' and select a location to save the zipped folder.
3. Once the folder has been saved to your computer, double click the folder to extract the files.
